1. Awareness Program on Democracy and Social Justice

On behalf of the Democracy Forum, Electoral Literacy Club and Student Council, an awareness programme on Democracy and Social Justice was held on 13.09.2023 for Shift I and Shift II respectively. Rev. Fr. Dr. S. Mariadoss S. J., the Principal presided over the programme. Mr. A. Kathir, the Executive Director of Evidence Organization, Madurai, was the chief guest. Dr. Aloysius Albert and Dr. Shamila Joster, the Deans of students arranged the events and Dr. Christopher, the Coordinator of the Democracy Forum and the team members organized the events.

2. World Democratic Day

On 15.9.2023, World Democratic Day was observed by the student members of the Democracy club with charts and placards related to Democracy and its elements such as Respect for Human Rights, Fundamental Rights, and Freedoms, Holding Free and Fair Elections, Adult Franchise, etc. Rev.Fr.
