A direct flash produced a very hard light, creating deep and defined shadows under his chin and in the background



Much softer and more pleasant light By simply bouncing the on-camera flash on the wall

The Most Common Light Patterns

- split lighting;
- loop lighting;
- butterfly lighting;
- Rembrandt lighting;
- Rim lighting;
- and Silhouette lighting.

Multiple Light Setups

- More subtle and complicated (நுட்பமான மற்றும் சிக்கலான) light patterns are possible with several lights.
- With more than one light, you can also separate your model from the background

- *key light,*
- *fill light,*
- *background light*



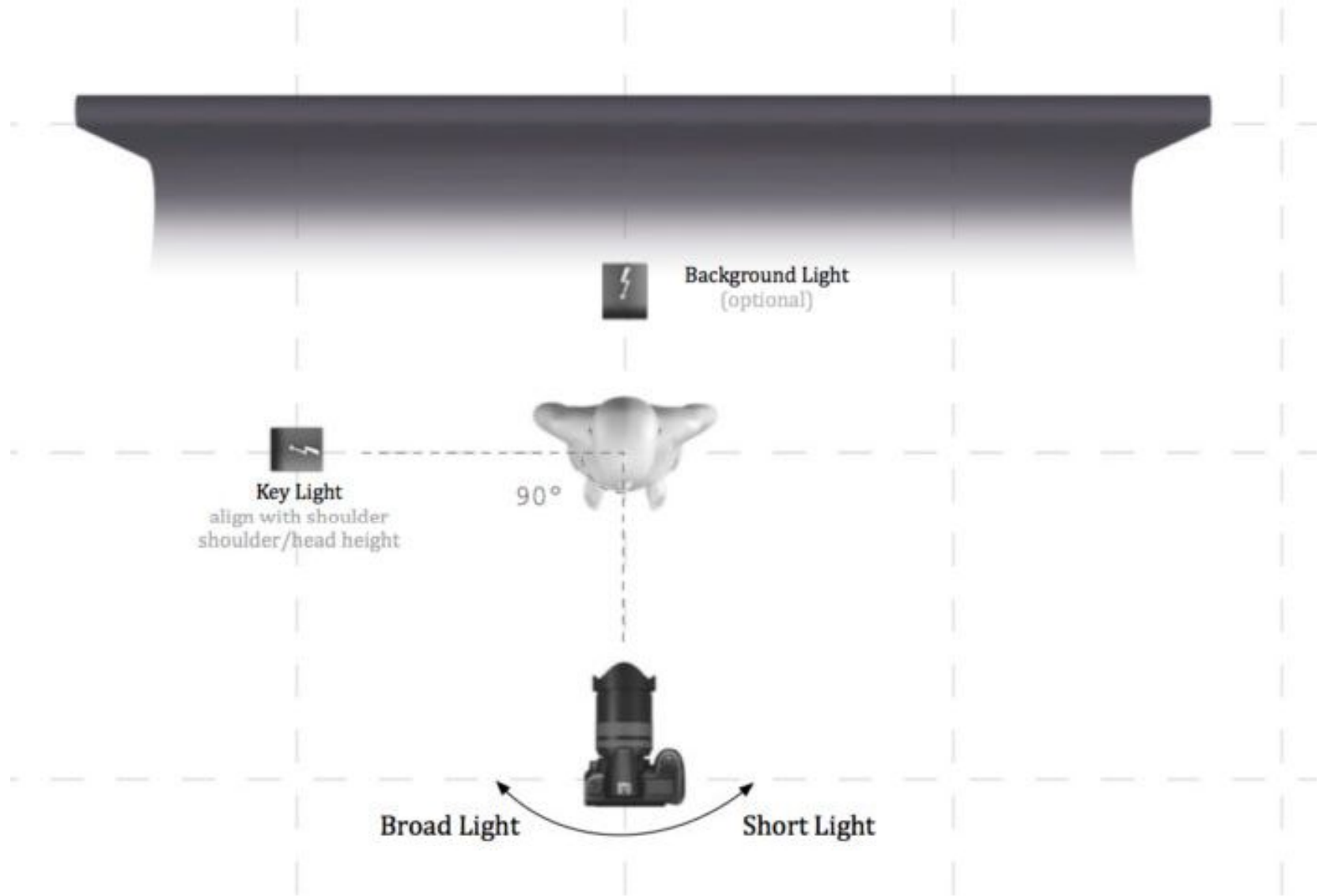

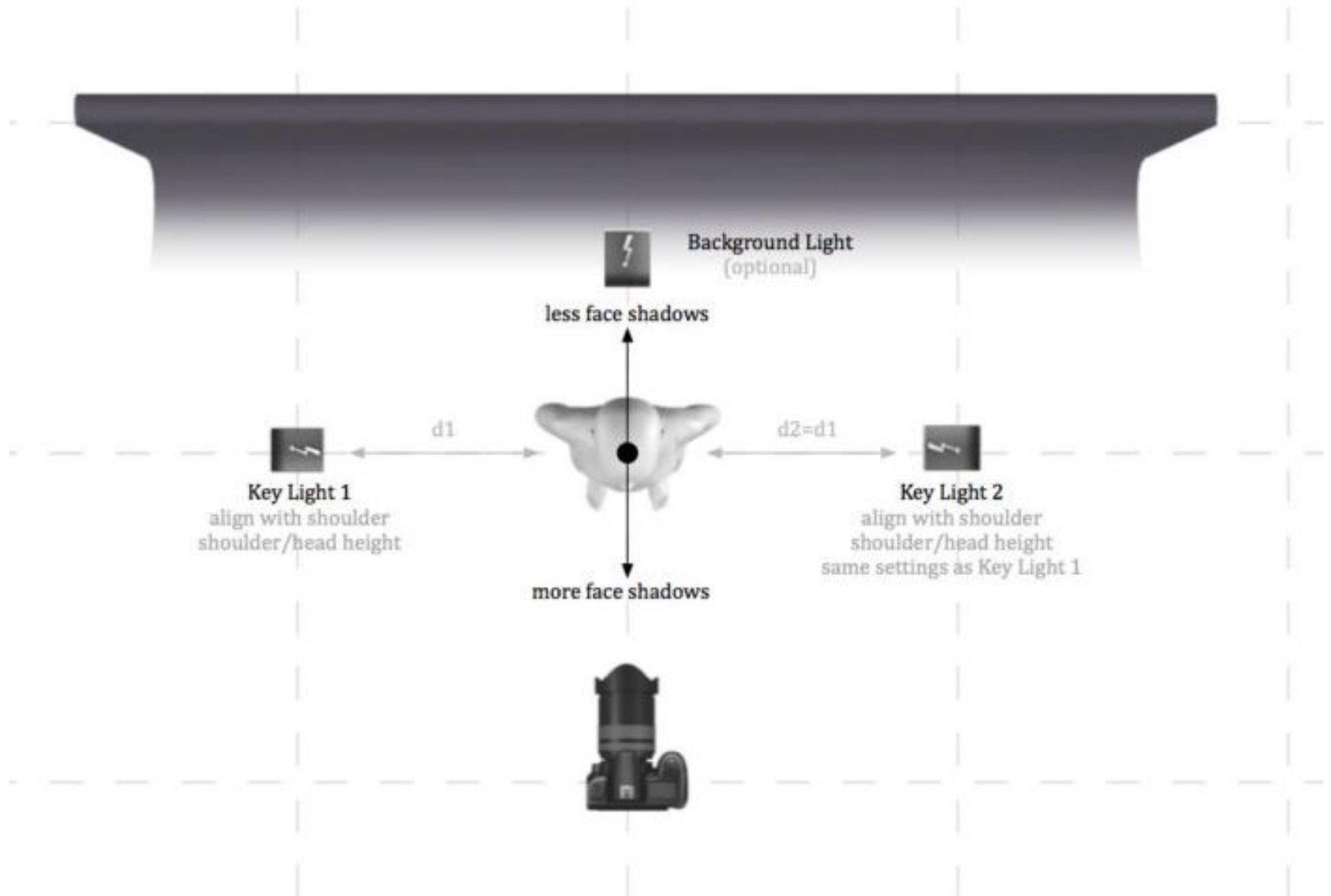


Hero Lighting

- It produces a strong shadow in the middle of your model's face

Loop Lighting



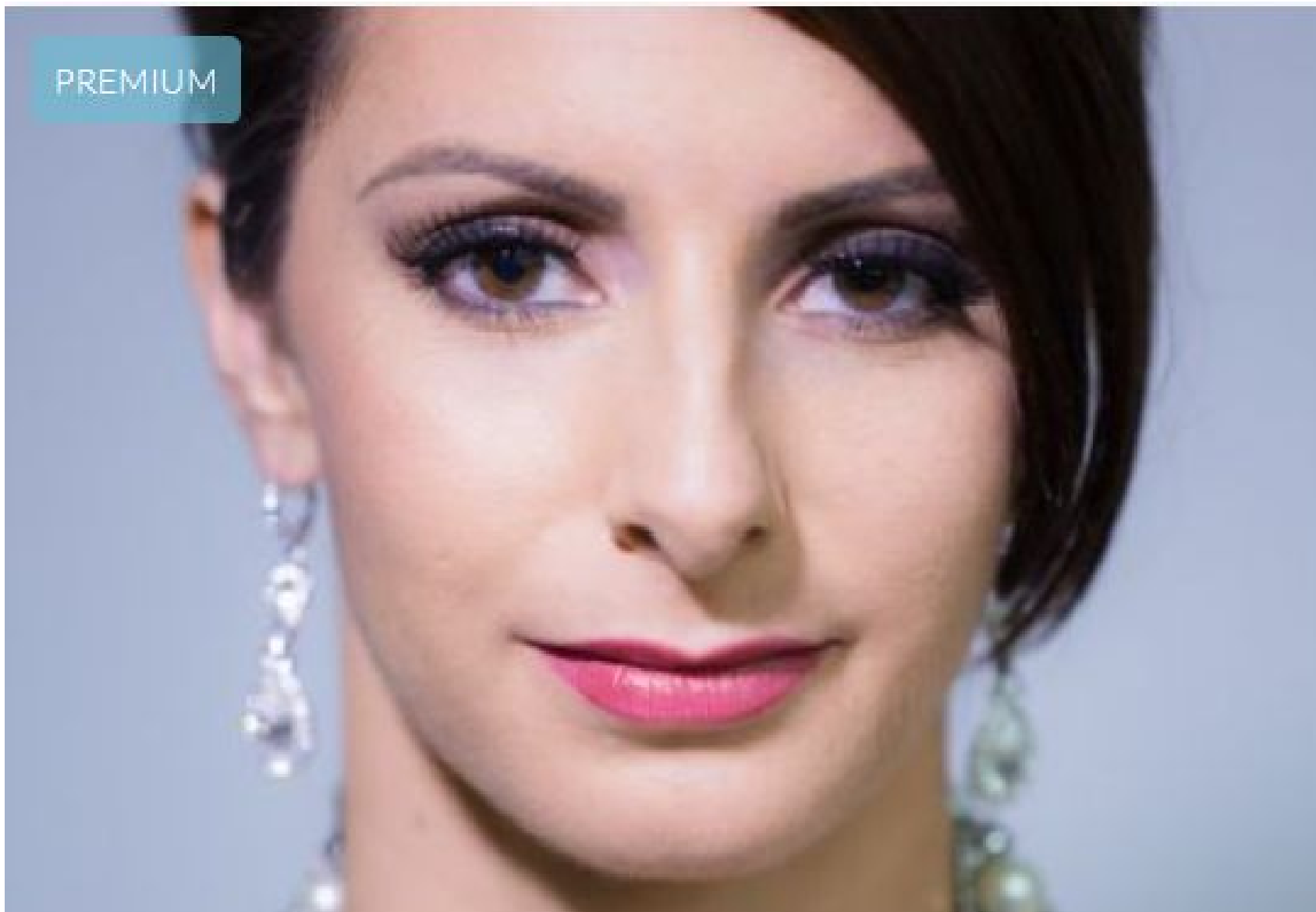
The key light covers the unlit side of the nose without extending onto the cheek

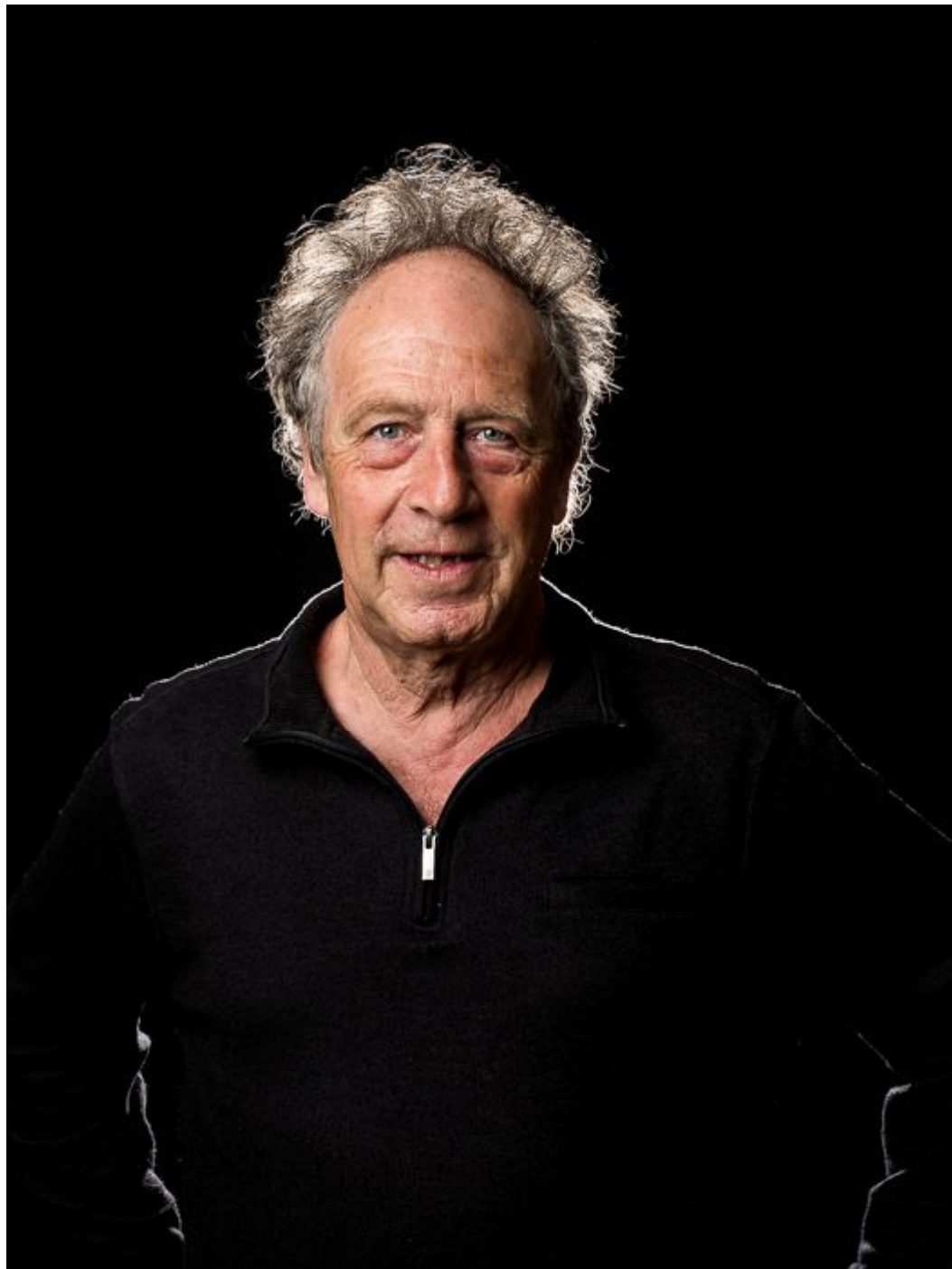

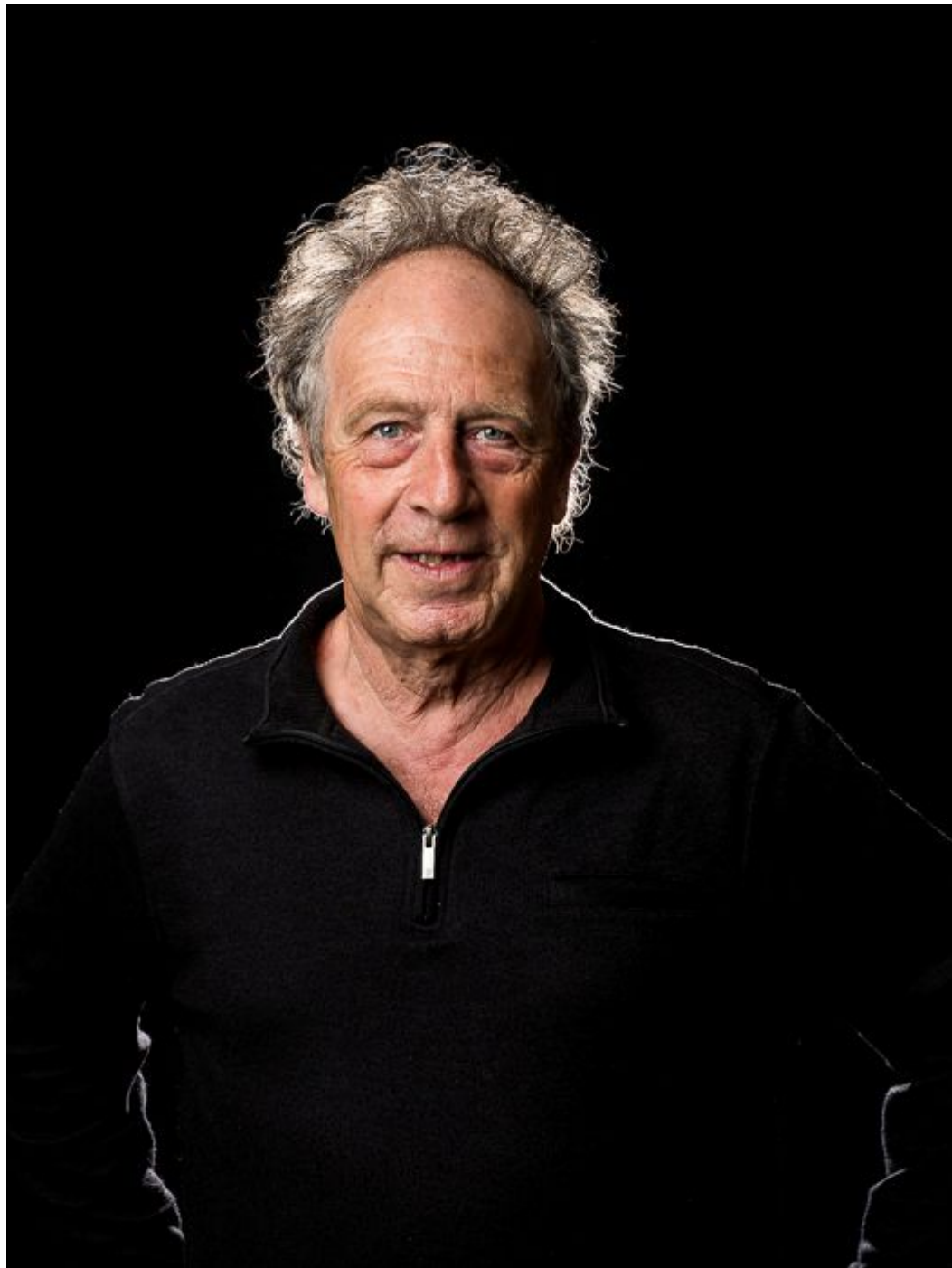

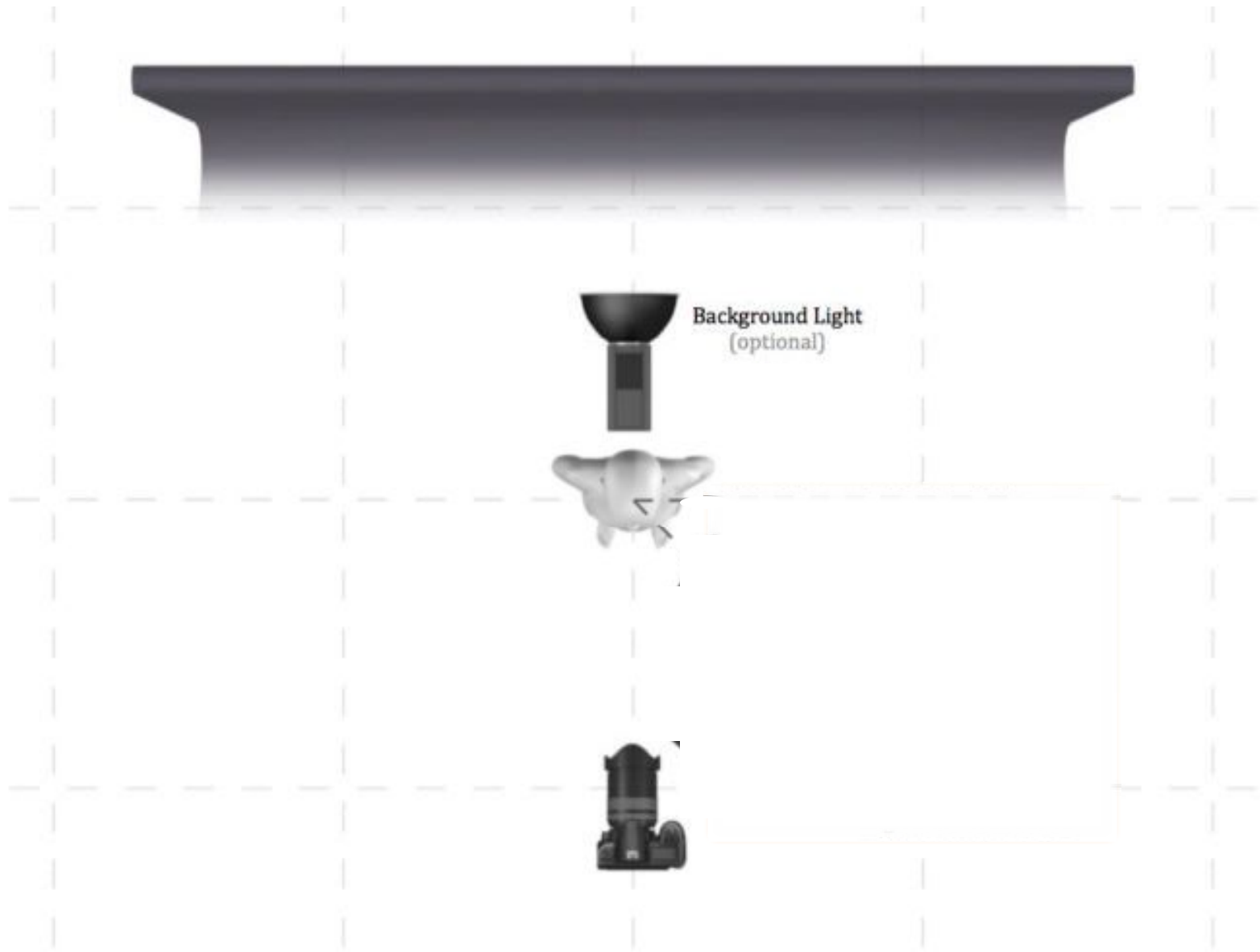




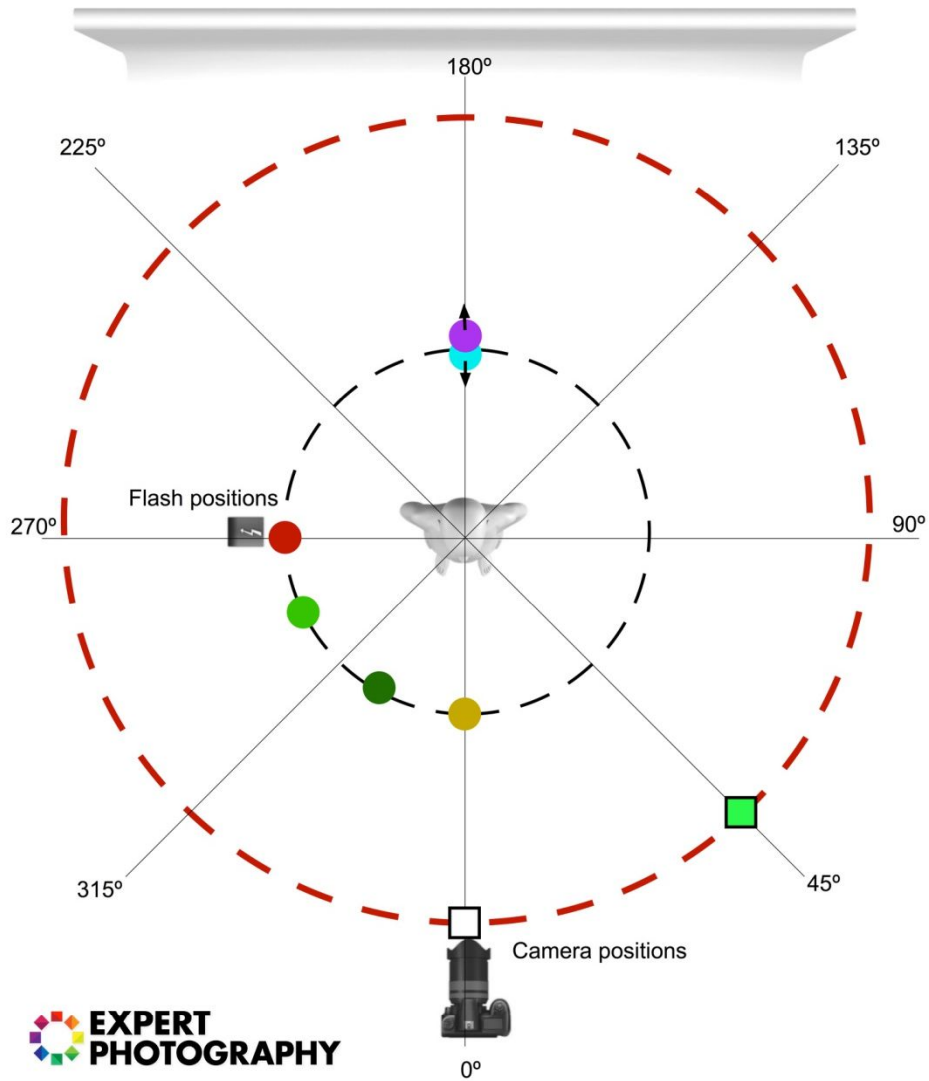

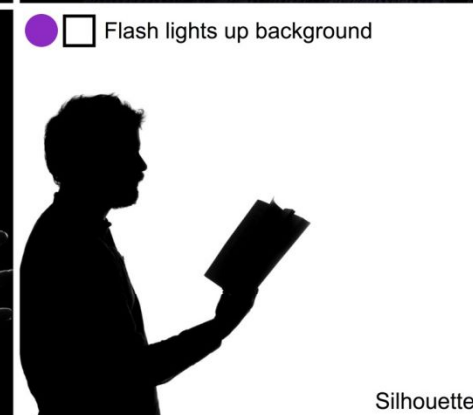
