**DATE: 08.12.2023 (FRIDAY)**

The SXC AICUF Unit organizes various activities keeping these three objectives in mind: social outreach, personality development, and spiritual growth. We aim to live up to the AICUF motto, "We are born into an unjust society, and we are determined not to leave it as we have found it." The SXC AICUF Unit organized a bike rally from IIP Laxmi Raman School, Uthamapandiankulam to Our College on December 8, 2023, to commemorate International Human Rights Day and raise awareness about human rights. Our AICUF students played a drama, "NattaiKapoom," which demonstrated human rights and the need to safeguard our nation with our valuable voting rights. Mr. Nellai Mubarak, State President, SDPI, presided over the function and mesmerized the audience with his thought-provoking speech. Rev. Fathers the Rector and the Secretary gave away the certificates to the prize winners of the AICUF literary event competitions and bike rally participants. Both shift students took the Human Rights Pledge. The human chain and drama were played again for the Shift-II students at 4.15 p.m. in front of the college church. As a whole, the International Human Rights Day programme was organized by all the service organizations at our college.








## **International Youth Day**
