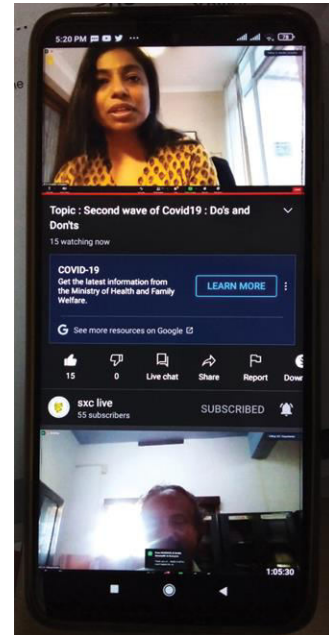

## IQAC Report 2021-2022

Quality is an ongoing process and not a one-time episode. National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is the agency instituted by the Government of India to assess and accredit all higher educational institutions in the country. In all NAAC accreditations, we have received the highest grade. In the fourth cycle also, we have received the highest grade in NAAC accreditation. NAAC introduced the Revised Accreditation Framework(RAF) to assess and accredit higher educational institutions in India from July 2017. IQAC submitted Self Study Report (SSR) to National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) as per the Revised Accreditation Framework so that our College could get accredited by NAAC in the fourth cycle. NAAC Peer Team Visit was held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019. NAAC assessed and accredited our Institution at A<sup>++</sup> Grade with a CGPA of 3.66 out of 4 in IV cycle. The CGPA of 3.66 (out of 4) placed St. Xavier's College, Palayamkottai in the FIRST position among the arts and science colleges accredited by NAAC in the whole country in 2019 under the Revised Accreditation Framework. We have grown from strength to strength. Everything proceeds from the Lord. We fully substantiate what Rev. Fr. Mahe, S. J. wrote in his diary when St. Xavier's College was established in 1923: *Digitus Dei est hic* (The finger of God is here)!



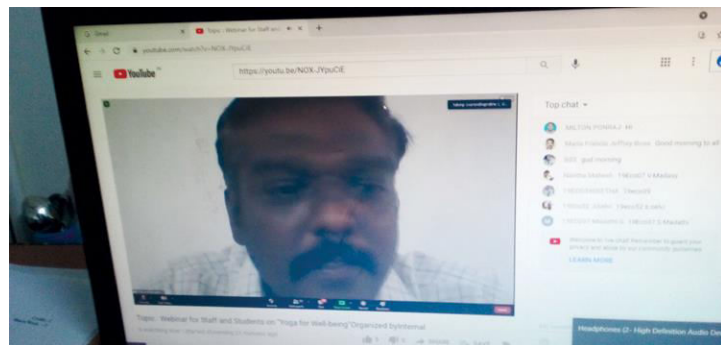

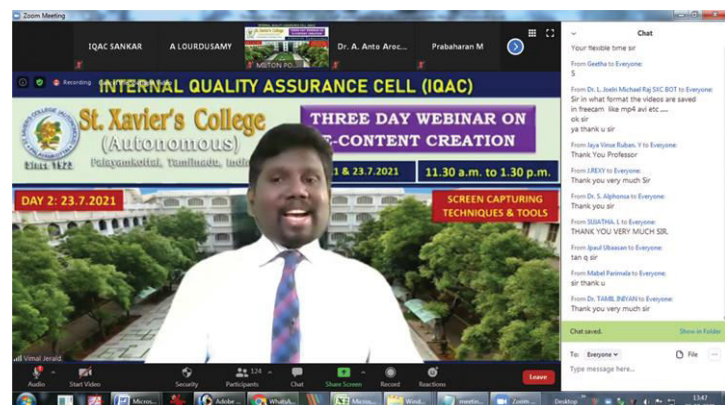

### 3. SWOC ANALYSIS

#### 3.1. Institutional Strengths:

- The college is identified as one of the best performing institutions in the country by MHRD based on the NAAC score in successive cycles.
- The college has 7-year accreditation period for NAAC accreditation.

- The college has 7 published Patents to its credit
- The curriculum of all disciplines is revised and updated periodically.
- Emphasis on moral and ethical education and enhancement of life skills
- Excellent outreach and community engagements especially through STAND



- College is having rich historical standing and reputation in the region.
- The college is equipped with good infrastructure for undertaking research.
- The campus has a functional Wi-Fi facility freely available to the students and faculty members including hostel inmates.
- The Institution has a sprawling clean & green campus spread over 58 acres of land
- The greenery in the campus is ensured with high diversity of trees and plants.
- The college promotes institutional values and socially responsible programmes on a large scale.
- Most of the teachers possess Ph.D. and NET/SLET eligibility
- The overall academic performance of the student is appreciable and pass percentage is also good.
- The slow learners are helped through remedial teaching, handouts and materials are provided for easy study and extra coaching and guidance are provided.
- Good infrastructure for imparting education and co-curricular activities.
- The college is blessed with the multifaceted and dedicated teachers who volunteer to shoulder additional responsibilities that support the administration of the college.

### 3.2. Institutional Weaknesses:

- The pass percentage of students in NET and SET is poor.
- There is lack of diversity among the students, for most of them belong to this region.
- Folklore Department has not utilized its full potentials

16. Conduct add on courses to prepare students to face competitive world

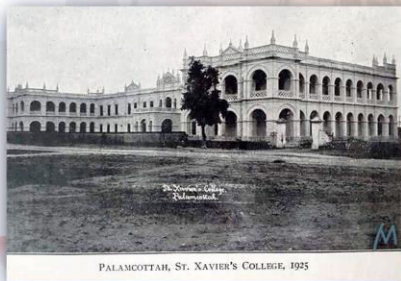
