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96th College Day

The College Day Celebrations were held on 23rd March 2019. The Chief Guest Dr. K. Pitchumani, the Vice-Chancellor of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli, enthused the students to act toward their desired goal that gives purpose and direction to behaviour for nation building. Rev. Dr. V. Henry Jerome S.J., Rector, St. Xavier's Institutions, Rev. Dr. A. Antonysamy S.J., Secretary, offered felicitations. Rev. Dr. V. Britto, S.J., Principal, presented the Annual Report, giving the details of the quality enhancement measures implemented in the academic year 2018-2019.



269 academic prizes, 38 special awards, and 87 endowment scholarships were distributed to students. The participation of the Jesuit Management, Teaching and Administrative Staff, Parents, Alumni, Guests and Students added colours to the 96th College Day celebrations.



The IQAC of our college is actively involved in ensuring that St. Xavier's College at Palayamkottai maintains and sustains the standards expected of it. In the academic year 2018-2019, the IQAC was actively involved in preparing the self-study report and submitting it for the fourth cycle of accreditation to NAAC.

IQAC conducted Orientation Programme for teachers on 30.06.2018. The teachers of Shift I who were appointed since June 2012 and all the teachers of Shift II attended the programme.



Workshop on SMART Class Facility explaining the facilities in the software Dual Pen 3.0 was organized on 24.08.2018. Dr. Leon Stephen Raj, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, was the Resource Person.



Workshop on SMART Class Facility explaining the facilities in FB150, CM2MAX and Visualizer was conducted on 25.08.2018. Dr. M. Safish Mary, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, was the Resource Person.



Student Feedback on Teachers in odd semester for the academic year 2018-2019 was conducted in October 2018. The feedback response was handed over to every staff member belonging to both Shift I and Shift II individually. The younger members of the staff of Shift I and all the staff members of Shift II met Rev. Fr. Secretary who instructed the staff with low score to improve their teaching learning process and change the methodology of teaching from task oriented to person-centred.

Department-wise Analysis of Feedback was handed over to the departments.

Feedback on Curricular Aspects from final year UG/PG and M.Phil. students was collected in October 2018. The report was sent to Chairmen of Boards of Studies of all disciplines so that suitable measures could be taken and implemented.

Participation in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF): Our college secured 74th Rank under college level category out of 1132 higher educational institutions participated in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) process across the country for the year 2019.

Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) was submitted to NAAC on 28th December 2018.

Assessment & Accreditation (A&A) by NAAC-2019: The Validity of Assessment and Accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) for our Institution got expired on 9th March 2019. The college prepared itself to submit Self Study Report (SSR) to NAAC (as per the new Manual) so that the college could get accredited by NAAC in the fourth cycle.



In view of preparing SSR, IQAC extracted the metrics and Data Templates pertaining to different constituencies of the college from NAAC Manual and distributed the same. Based on the Questionnaire sent, IQAC conducted an Academic Audit for all constituencies of the college from 03.10.2018 to 07.11.2018.

Trim Tab: Imagine you are at the helm of a huge ship moving forward at high speed. You are the driver. You control the direction of the ship. Now, how is it possible for a single, small person to change the course of something so massive? To change the ship's course, you move a steering wheel that operates a rudder itself which then turns the ship. But the rudder can be enormous, perhaps even 10 stories tall on some ocean liners. Scholarship to Students

This year the college office has facilitated 1021 students to receive Government scholarship to the tune of Rs. 41,87,553/-. Every year the college management provides Rs.10 lakh to help the students belonging to the marginalized sections of the society. 281 students received financial aid this year. The management also provided mid-day meals to 168 students to the tune of Rs. 9,93,950/-. The inmates of the college hostel enjoy the special benefit of monthly fees concession from Rev. Fr. Rector which supports more than 180 students to the tune of Rs. 3,65,000/-.

ENVIRO CLUB

The Enviro Club raises awareness on issues of the environment among our students. This academic year, an anti-plastic usage awareness rally was held. The students performed a "Street Play" to the public on the harmful effects of plastic bags and suggested to use "Jute Bags". LIBRARY

Our college library has a pride of place in our hearts. It has a total number of 1,32,215 volumes and back volumes of 3835. The Library stack has been added with 1525 new books and 121 Journals and magazines in various disciplines. The membership with British Council Library for the reference service has been renewed and the DELNET service, INFLIBNET and N-List access also has been continued in this academic year. This year, RFID technology has been introduced in our library. The library has launched WEB-OPAC and it can be accessed by the users and public from the College Website: www.stxavierstn.edu.in round the clock. Electronic Resource Management Package for e-journals provides the accessibility to e-resources through Digital Library of St. Xavier's College.





Rev. Dr. V. BRITTO S.J., Principal, St. Xavier's College, has served this institution for a period of 18 years in the Department of Folklore. He is a man of multidisciplinary to his credit as he specialized himself in the fields of Physics, Political Science, Folklore and Musicology. He studied M. A. Ethnomusicology at Queen's University of Belfast in North Ireland in the year 1997-1998. He has completed one minor project titled "The impact of music in Ritual contexts" funded by UGC. He was the Director of Folklore Resources and Research Centre (FRRC), Campus Minister, Advisor of AICUF and Director of Fine Arts and from 2007 to 2013, he served as the Rector of Xaverian Institutions. He has edited three volumes of the Journal of South Indian Folklorist and published nearly 25 articles both in Tamil and English.

Rev. Dr. V. Britto S.J. is a man steeped in spirituality. He has a deep and abiding faith in God and his faith is reflected in his actions. A true Jesuit to the core, he has always worked keeping in mind the Ignatian principle of Magis.

Rev. Dr. SAHAYARAJ, S.J., was the founder Director of (STAND), the outreach programme of St. Xavier's College, when it was launched in 1993. He was the Director of STAND from 1993-1996, 2001, 2012-14 and 2017-2019. He was also the Student Counsellor in 2001-2002 during which he has systematized counselling by bringing out a Manual for mentoring. Apart from the above tasks he was the Campus Minister, Alumni Director and Foundation Course coordinator. As FRRC Director during 2012-2013 he has organized GRAMIYAM, a unique programme at the FRRC Centre inviting school students around neighbouring area for two days of Folk performance competition. He also served as Vice-Principal from 2014-2016. He was instrumental in planting 1300 trees in Xavier Hostel with the initiative of converting it into Green Campus. He has been awarded four Minor Research Projects by ICHR, United Board, etc.



DR. D. PATRIC RAJA has completed 36 years of teaching (2 years at SJC & 34 years SXC) and he has 25 years of research experience in our institution. He has completed 2 major projects (as co-investigator) and six minor projects funded by UGC, TNSCST, AIACHE and UBCHEA. He has published four books on environmental science and seaweeds. He has also published 27 research articles in national and international journals under his able guidance 5 research scholars have been awarded PhD degree and 10 scholars have been awarded M. Phil degree. He held many positions such as Nature Club Co-ordinator, Environment Club Coordinator; NSS Programme Officer and Admission Committee Officer.

Dr. A. LAURENCE SELVARAJ, the Director of Physical Education, joined this college in July 1988. He has worked with sincerity and dedication for 31 years. He has received the Best Director of Physical Education award from the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University for the year 2013 - 2014. He has been the Coordinator of the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Sports coordination committee in the years 2013-2015 and he was the member of the Sports Coordination committee in the year 2015-2016. He has served the College in various capacities as member of Discipline Committee, Academic Council, College Council, Student Council adviser, the Chief Superintendent of Examination and taught foundation course for two decades. In all these years he has been a friend, guide and philosopher of the students in their growth.



Dr. V. IRUDAYARAJ, has had a life devoted to research and teaching. His work on the "Cytotaxonomic studies on the fern flora of the Western Ghats" is one of the classical studies undertaken in Pteridology in India. He joined the Department of Botany in the year 2001 and brought the full force of his knowledge of ferns into his teaching. An avid reader and enthusiastic field scientist, he is one of the top minds in the field of pteridophyte research in India and has been presented with Life Time Achievement Award by the Indian Fern Society. One of the achievements of his career was the publication of the book Pteridophyte Flora of the Western Ghats, South India along with Dr. V. S. Manickam S. J. Apart from his academic pursuits, he is also known as a skilled photographer and he is also a part-time poet who regales students and staff alike with his witty poems which are full of references to plants and pteridophytes.



Mr. S. A. DEVARAJ, the Office Superintendent, joined St. Xavier's College in June 1982 as an Electrician. From 1987 to 1992 he worked in the Office of the Controller of Examinations.
