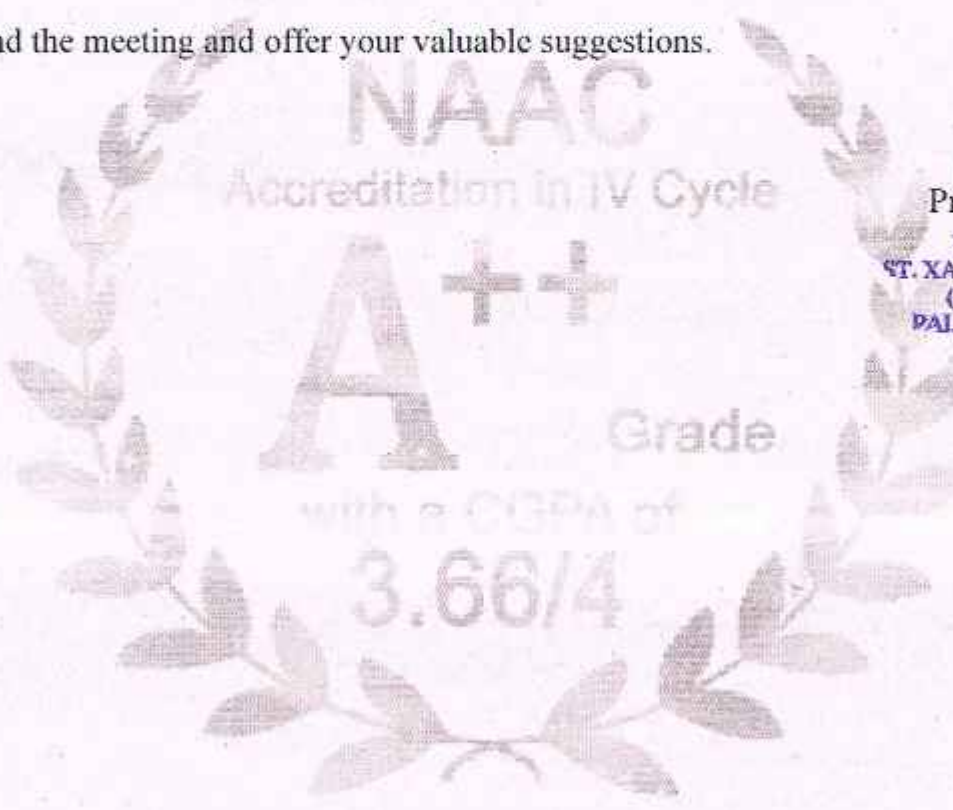





### **I. a. Introduction**

St. Xavier's was established at Palayamkottai in 1923 by Jesuit Fathers of the Jesuit Madurai Province with an aim of preparing generations of students for a happy, healthy and harmonious life. It is a grant-in-aid, institution recognized by the UGC Act under sections 2(f) and 12(B). The college is affiliated to the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. In recognition of its service and excellence, the college was granted autonomy in 1987.

The NAAC accredited at A++ grade with a CGPA of 3.66 out of 4 in IV cycle in 2019. In the ranking conducted by NIRF, the college ranks 68<sup>th</sup> in College Category in 2022 - 2023.

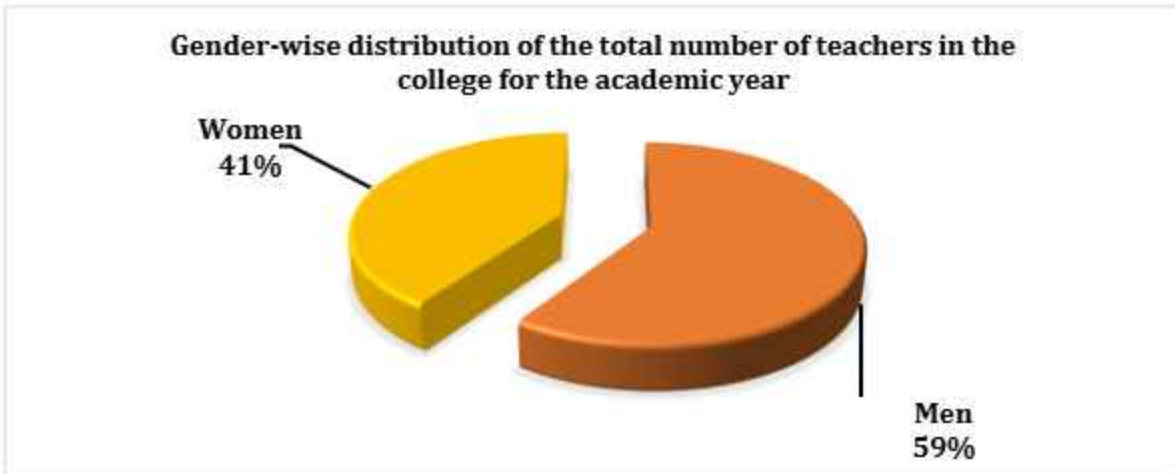

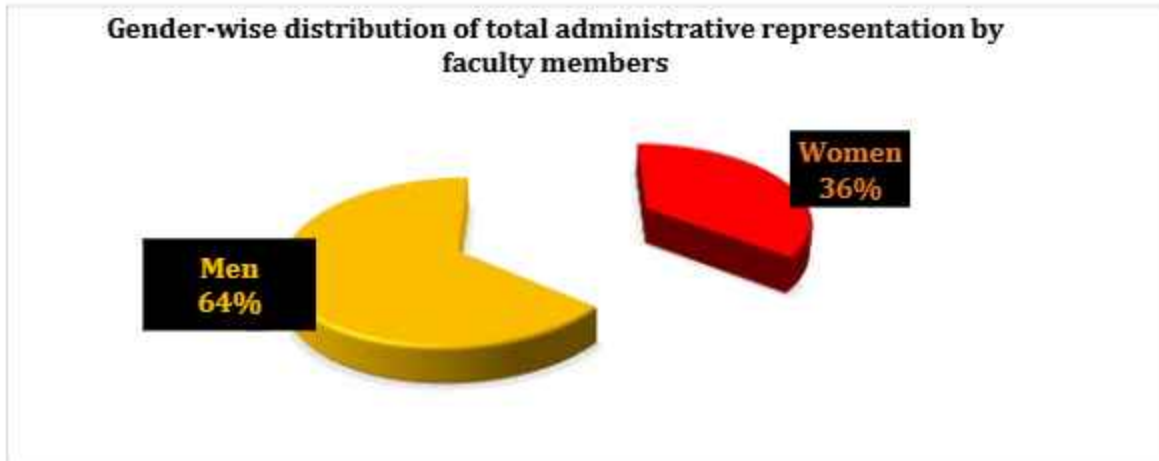

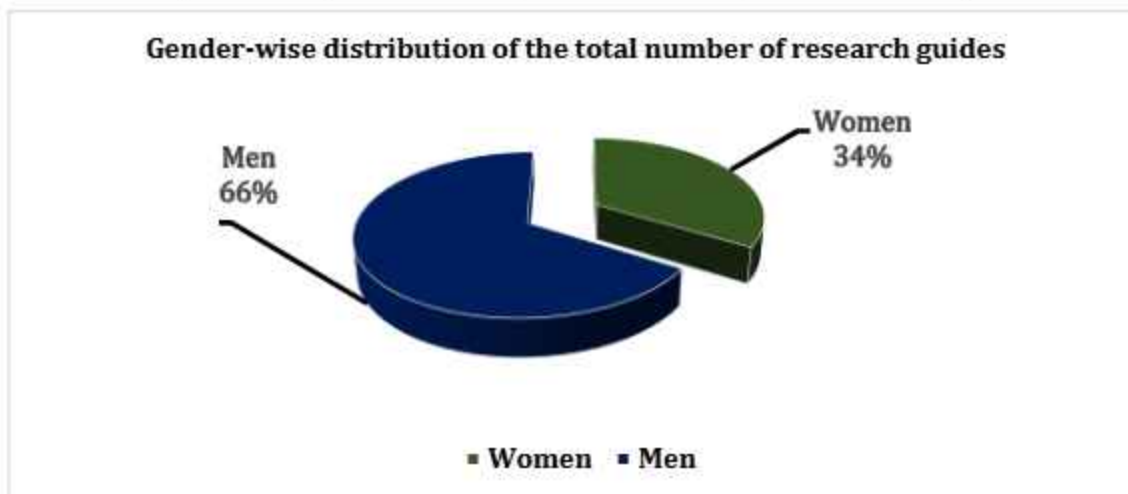

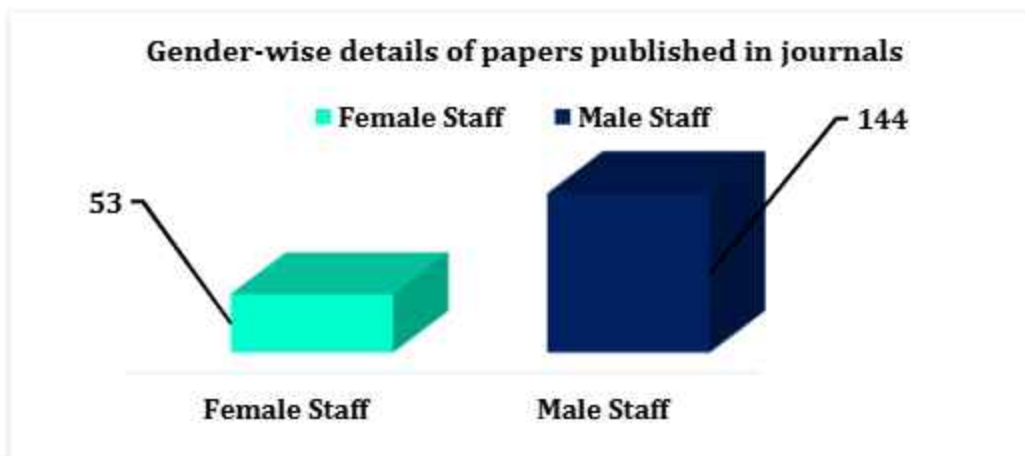

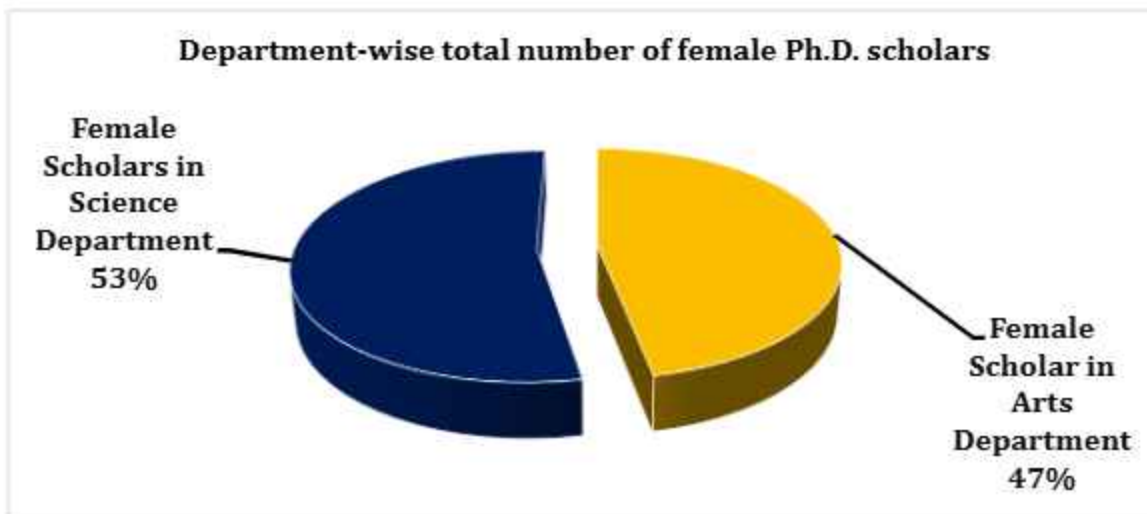
**Table: IV. g. Gender-wise distribution of Ph.D. scholars in the college (2022-2023)**

**Table: IV. h. Department-wise total number of female Ph.D. scholars (2022-2023)**

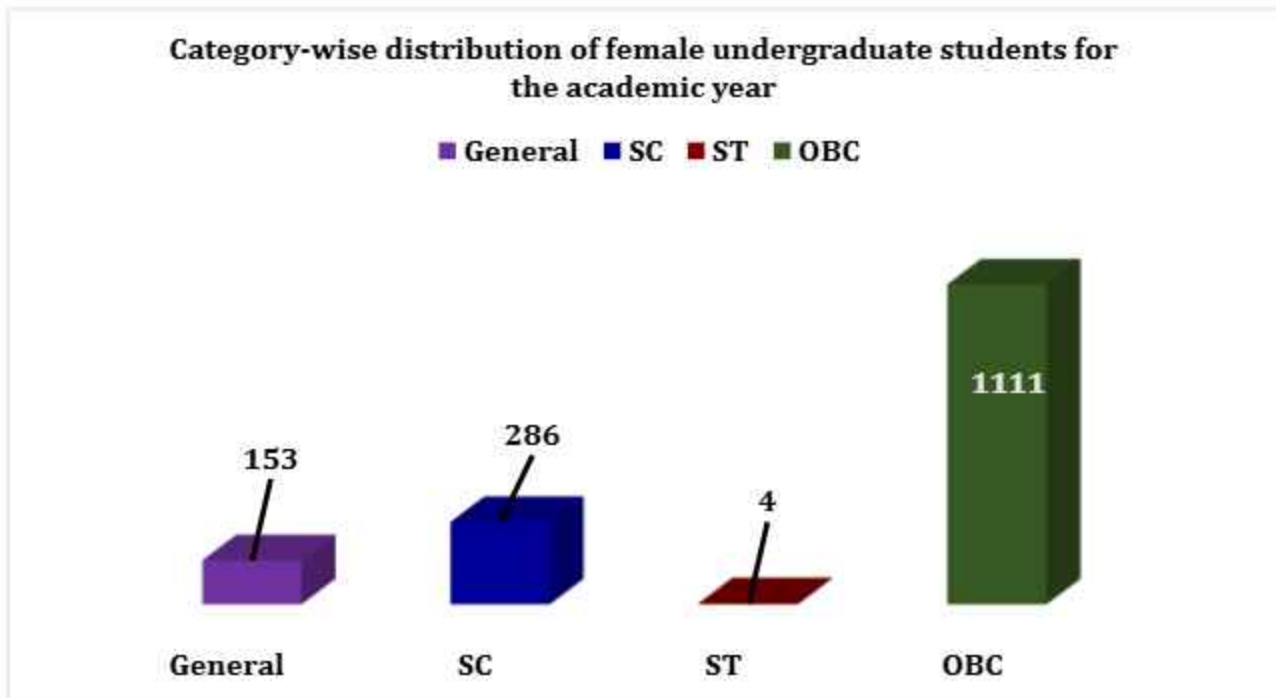

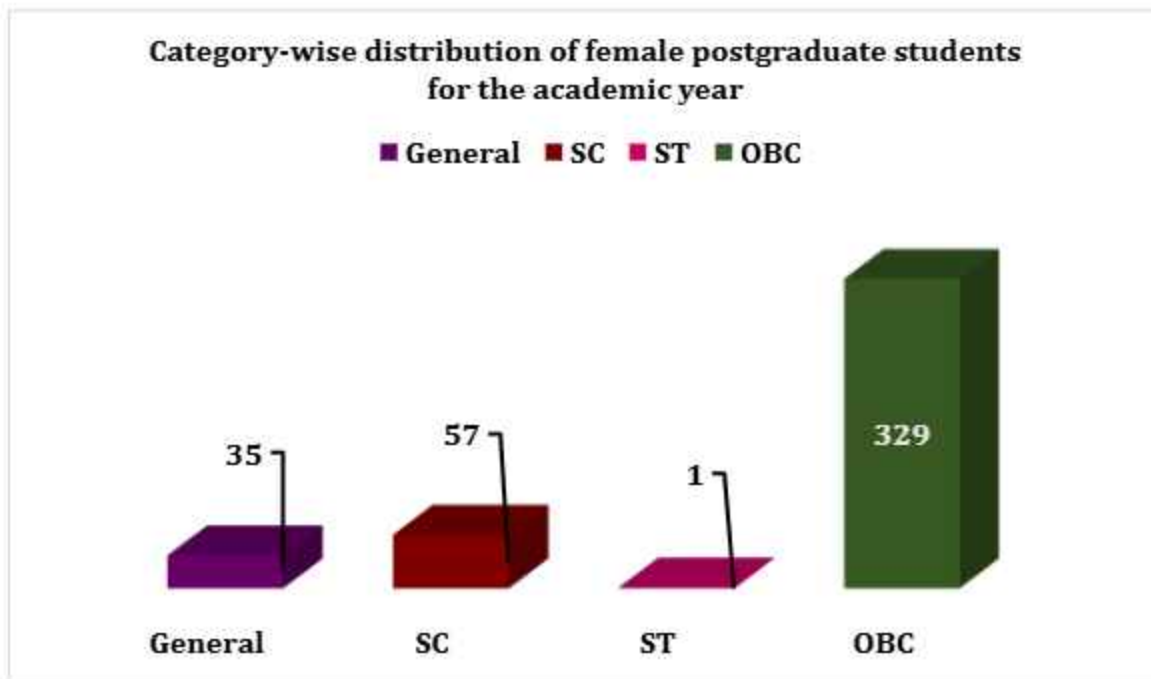

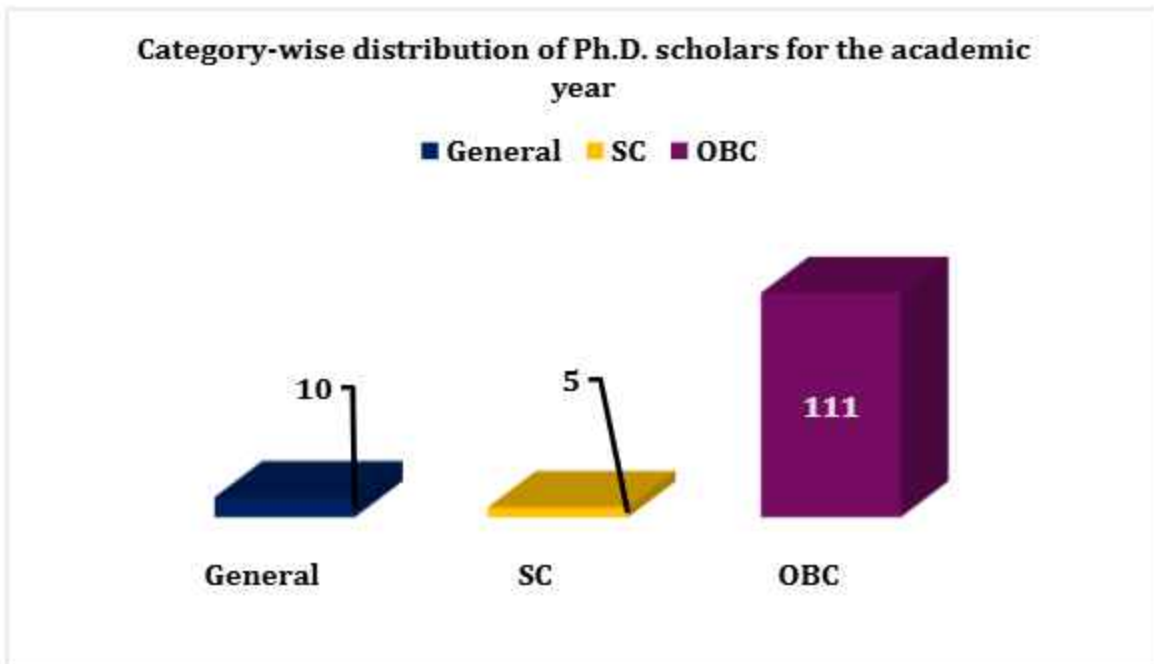
**Table: V. b. Category-wise distribution of female postgraduate students for the academic year 2022-2023**

**Table: V. c. Category-wise distribution of Ph.D. scholars for the academic year 2022-2023**

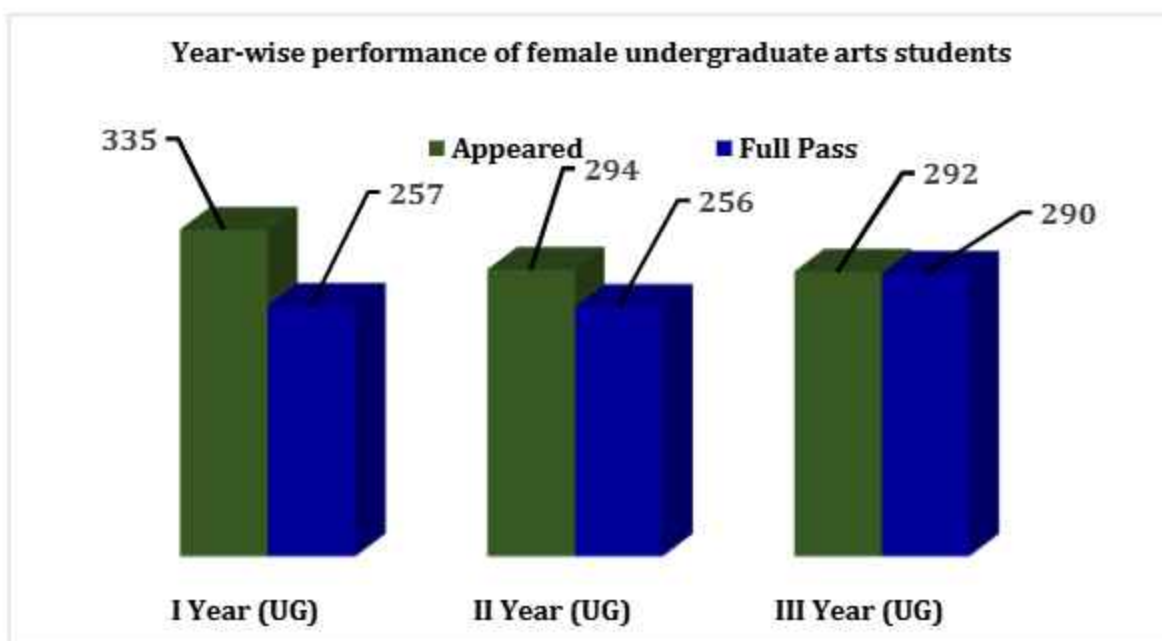

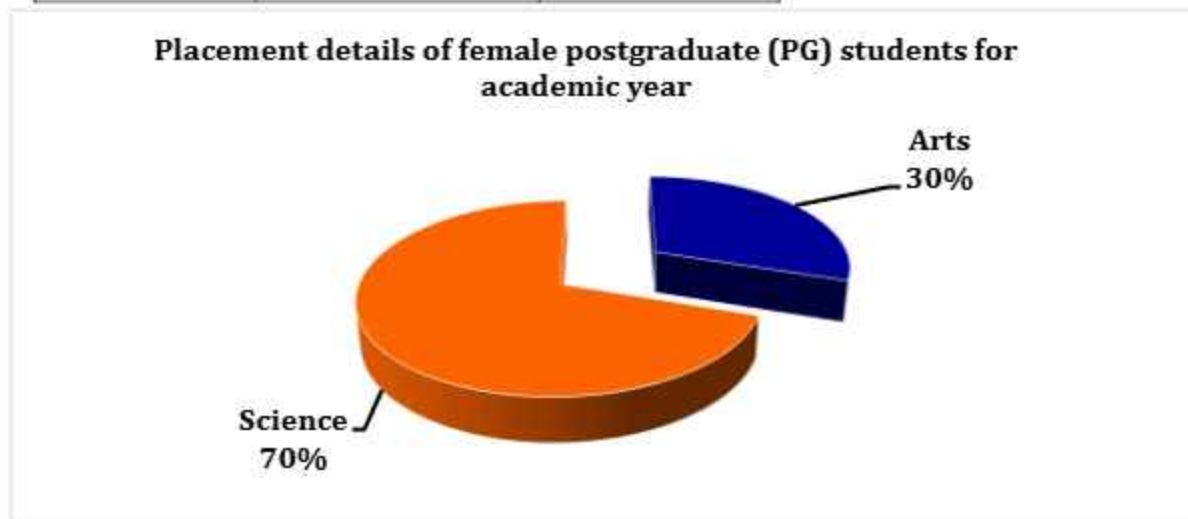

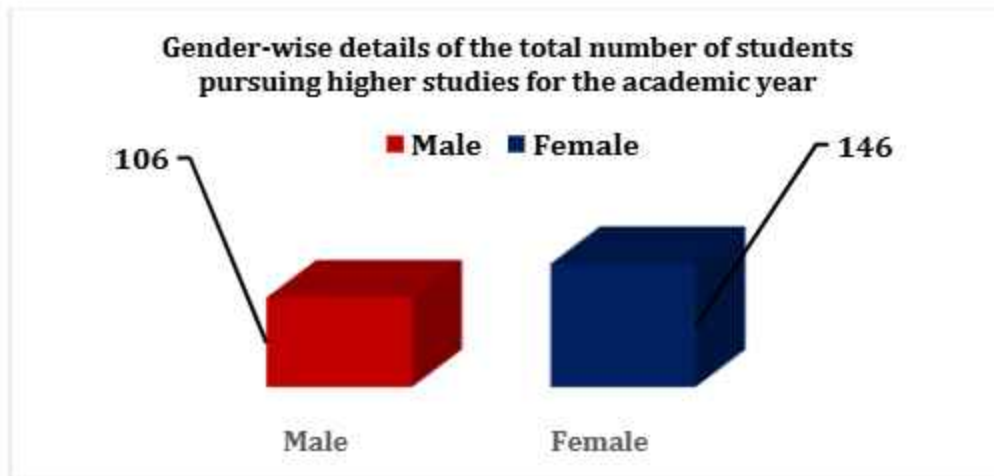

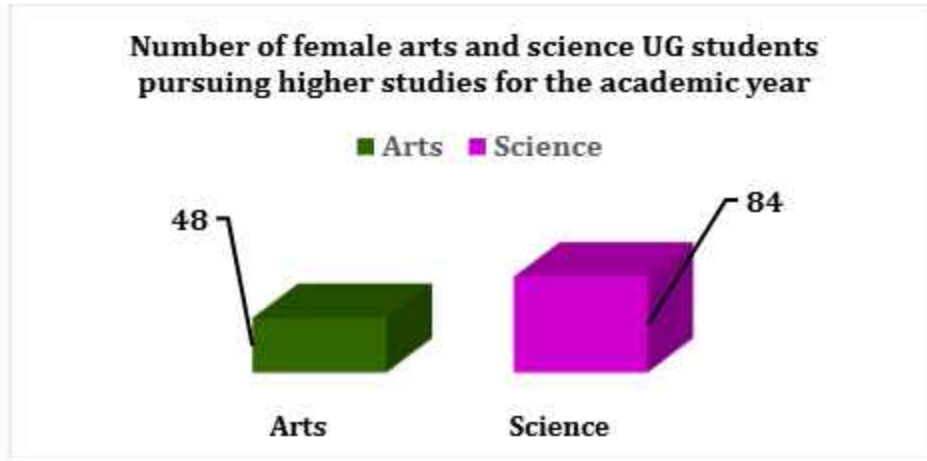

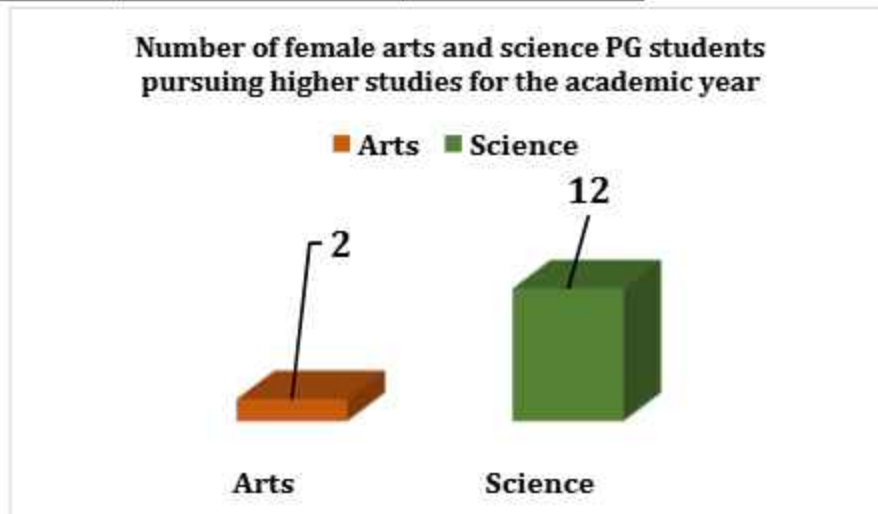
