

I. a. Introduction

St. Xavier's was established at Palayamkottai in 1923 by Jesuit Fathers of the Jesuit Madurai Province with an aim of preparing generations of students for a happy, healthy and harmonious life. It is a grant-in-aid, institution recognized by the UGC Act under sections 2(f) and 12(B). The college is affiliated to the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. In recognition of its service and excellence, the college was granted autonomy in 1987.

 Overall, gender audits are a crucial tool for HEIs to strive towards a more equitable and inclusive educational experience for all.








Table: III. b. Gender-wise distribution of total administrative representation by faculty members for 2022-2023




Table: III. c. Gender-wise distribution of the total number of research guides for 2022-2023




Table: III. d. Gender-wise details of papers published in journals from 2022-2023








Table: IV. c. Department-wise total number of female undergraduate students (2022-2023)




Table: IV. d Gender-wise distribution of postgraduate students in the college (2022-2023)




Table: IV. e. Year-wise total number of female postgraduate students (2022-2023)




Table: IV. f. Department-wise total number of female postgraduate students (2022-2023)




Table: IV. g. Gender-wise distribution of Ph.D. scholars in the college (2022-2023)







Table: V. b. Category-wise distribution of female postgraduate students for the academic year 2022-2023





Table: V. c. Category-wise distribution of Ph.D. scholars for the academic year 2022-2023




Table: VI. b. Year-wise Performance of Female Undergraduate Science Students




Table: VI. c. Year-wise Performance of Female Postgraduate Arts Students





Table: VI. d. Year-wise Performance of Female Postgraduate Science Students








Table: VIII. b. Placement Details of Female Students for the Academic Year 2022-2023




Table: VIII. c. Placement Details of Female Undergraduate (UG) Students for Academic Year 2022-2023







Table: IX. b. Number of female UG and PG students pursuing higher studies for the academic year





